The role of the Sports Shed Monitors is to accurately issue and return of all sports equipment that the children require. Ensuring that the sports shed is remained tidy and efficient. To follow up on any outstanding sports equipment and note down any damaged equipment that requires repair.

Who can be a Sports Shed Monitor?

- The Student Technicians will consist of 15 year 5,6,7 or 8 students who meet the below criteria and are successful in their application.
- Students will work in groups of 3 when requested by a teacher to run the sports shed.
- Student's applications must be accompanied by a teacher signature endorsing their application and a parent signature in support of their application.

Key Attributes of a Sports Shed Monitor:

- Be a role model of the school values.
- Be well organised, trustworthy and reliable.
- Be well mannered and able to communicate effectively with both students and teachers.
- Have confidence and experience with a variety of sports equipment.
- Be able to quietly and efficiently set up the daily routine of the sports shed.
- Support and participate in training when requested.
- Know how and when to seek help.

How to apply to be a Sports Shed Monitor:

- You will need to apply for the position.
In your application you will need to include:
 - ⇒ Name, age, year level,
 - ⇒ any experience you may have that will show us how good you will be at the job,
 - ⇒ what great qualities you can bring to the job,
 - ⇒ why you think we should choose you,
 - ⇒ **a note at the bottom of your letter from your parents saying that they support your application as a Sports shed monitor.**
 - ⇒ **a teacher signature endorsing your application.**
- You may need to be interviewed.
