

West Melton Eco Warriors (x15-25 Yr 5-8)

The **Eco Warrior** has a wide range of roles and duties where they will be required to complete each week.

These students need to demonstrate a caring attitude about our school environment and the wider community/global environment. They will be willing to learn and contribute to the education of the school as a whole on environmental issues.

Who can be an Eco Warrior?

- The Eco Warriors will consist of 15 to 25 x year 5,6,7 or 8 students who meet the below criteria and are successful in their application.
- They will take part in training and skill building.
- An Eco Warrior has to be willing to stand up for environmental issues.
- Student's applications must be accompanied by a parent signature AND a teacher signature supporting their application.

Key Attributes of an Eco Warrior:

Be a role model of the school values.

- Be well organized and reliable.
- Be enthusiastic and friendly.
- Participate in training and attend meetings when requested.
- Know how and when to seek help.
- · Be willing to educate the school about environmental issues
- Be an environmental advocate.
- Learn about and understand recycling systems and sustainability-systems that look after our school environment
- · Look after the warm farms, the school gardens and school wide recycling
- Be an advocate for litter-free lunch boxes
- Be willing to have speaking roles in assemblies
- Participate in wider school opportunities such as camps and competitions

How to apply to be an Eco Warrior:

You will need to apply for the position either in writing or digitally.

In your application you will need to include:

- ⇒ name, age, year level,
- ⇒ any experience you may have that will show us how good you will be at the job,
- ⇒ what great qualities you can bring to the job,
- ⇒ why you think we should choose you,
- ⇒ a note from your parents saying that they support your application as a <u>Eco Warrior</u> which may interfere with your classroom programme.
- ⇒ a teacher signature endorsing your application.
- You may need to attend an interview.
