



West Melton Reporters (x2)

The role of the Reporter is to assist Mrs Spadoni in reporting on school wide events. Be able to think creatively and work co-operatively with the news team. Be able to report on a variety of school event as and when required.

Who can be a Reporter?

- The Reporters will consist of 2x year 6, 7 or 8 students who meet the below criteria and are successful in their application.
- Students will work as a team to film, report on and edit current events happening at WMS.
- Student's applications must be accompanied by a teacher signature endorsing their application and a parent signature in support of their application.

Key Attributes of a Reporter:

- Be a role model of the school values.
- Be well organised, trustworthy and reliable.
- Be well mannered and able to communicate effectively with both students and teachers.
- Have confidence and experience with computers, camera's & recording equipment.
- Be prepared to learn and follow safe usage instructions of the school IT systems.
- You need to have good communication skills as you may need to meet with visitors to the school, classroom teachers and students.
- Have an awareness of news worthy events that are happening around the school.
- Give up some of your play or lunch time to set up and/or complete filming requirements.
- Be able to listen to and follow instructions.
- Support and participate in training when requested.
- Know how and when to seek help.

How to apply to be a Reporter:

- You will need to apply for the position.
 - In your application you will need to include:**
 - ⇒ Name, age, year level
 - ⇒ any experience you may have that will show us how good you will be at the job. Include participation in last year's workshop, if you attended it.
 - ⇒ what qualities you can bring to the job
 - ⇒ why you think we should choose you
 - ⇒ **a note from your parents saying that they support your application as a Reporter, which may interfere with your classroom programme.**
 - ⇒ **a teacher signature endorsing your application.**
- You may need to be interviewed.
