Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Congratulations, your child has been selected to represent West Melton Primary School at the Selwyn Central/Lincoln Zone Cross Country on **Monday 27th May 2019** (*pp Fri 31st May*). The Canterbury Championships will be held on Wednesday 19th June (*pp Wednesday 26th June*). ***This is not a compulsory event.*** If you do not wish for your child to compete, please state this on Kindo.

Venue & Transport

The Selwyn Central Zone Cross Country will be held at Halswell Quarry Park on Kennedy's Bush Road, Halswell. We will be leaving school at **11am** and travelling by bus, to assemble at the venue at 12pm. Cost of the bus is **\$8**. Car parking will be available at the Cashmere Road end of the Park, and the main entrance to the Quarry Park. **All children are expected to be back at school after 3pm.**

Uniform

Children will be expected to wear the WMS Sport uniform on the day. The fee for hiring one from the school is **\$6**.

Parent Helpers

We will need ***one parent helper to marshal*** on the course, as the teacher attending has to be involved with supervising the team.

EOTC Transport & Volunteer Agreement

We require our parent helpers to fill out the EOTC Transport & Volunteer Agreement (Marshalling/Supervising/Safety Vehicle) and return to the office with the permission form (or email back to Rita Spadoni rita.spadoni@westmelton.school.nz). *If you have already filled out one of these forms this year, you do not need to do it again.*

*The course may have some changes to that used in 2017.

Rules

No spiked shoes or bare feet. Parents are requested to ***stay clear of the finishing area and not to encroach on the track during the races*** and to allow the marshals to do their job effectively. Runners are requested to stay in the competitors' area before and after completing their event. Water bottles are to be used for drinking, not refreshing runners as they pass by!
